Since the onset of this virus, we have had 90 residents and 59 staff members test positive for COVID-19. We continue bi-weekly testing based on the county positivity rate which is currently 19.2%. We have no active resident COVID cases at this time. Our last facility-wide testing was on January 18, 2021 for residents and staff. We have had 59 staff recover and 85 residents. Currently we have 0 positive residents in the facility.

As always, we are working hard to keep everyone in our community safe and we will continue to practice the enhanced safety precautions that are known to prevent the spread of COVID-19, such as only essential personnel are allowed inside the facility and we screen them for signs and symptoms of illness prior to entering. Our residents are continually monitored and staff is using PPE as recommended by the CDC. Staff is frequently reminded and encouraged to practice social distancing and to use hand sanitizer and frequently wash their hands when they are in the facility and out in the community. We ask them not to report to work if they have symptoms of illness.

Walgreens was here on January 13, 2021 and administered the first dose of the COVID-19 vaccine. All residents and staff who consented to vaccine received the Pfizer vaccine. The 2nd dose of vaccine is scheduled for February 3, 2021. Our next scheduled date for the 2nd dose of the Pfizer COVID19 vaccine is February 3rd, 2021.
