VISITATION STATUS

We are excited to welcome you to *Spanish Hills Wellness Suites* for visits with your loved ones! While our residents cannot wait to see you and we are looking forward to having family members visit, please understand visitations will be conducted very differently than in the past for the purpose of protecting our residents and staff's safety, as well as your own. As such, and in line with the most recent recommendations from CMS, please read below for some general visitation requirements and information that you should know prior to visiting your loved one.

Beginning March 1st, you will be able to schedule an appointment with the Receptionist for visits beginning March 8th.

Visitation will take place in the front lobby utilizing a plexiglass barrier.

There will be 5 open time periods to schedule a visit Monday - Friday and 4 on Sunday.

Visitation times to schedule are: Monday thru Friday starting at 11am, 1pm, 2pm, 3pm, and 6pm.

Sunday visits may be scheduled at 1pm, 2pm, 3pm, and 6pm.

Visits will last 30 minutes, to allow the Receptionist time to sanitize between visits.

The Receptionist will ensure that all residents have an opportunity to meet with their loved ones before duplicate resident visits. Please be mindful that we have approximately 130 residents at any given time in the facility, all of whom are as eager to see their loved ones as you.

Please note that each resident can have only 2 visitors at a time.

Each visitor will be screened and temperatures recorded. All visitors must adhere to the following mandatory infection protocol guidelines: masks, social distancing, and use of hand sanitizer.

Please also note that should the rate of infection in the County exceed 10% and/or a positive case of Covid in the building occurs, visitation may be revised to meet guidelines.

We continue to practice the enhanced safety precautions that are known to prevent the spread of COVID-19, such as only essential personnel are allowed inside the facility and we screen them for signs and symptoms of illness prior to entering. Our residents are continually monitored and staff is using PPE as recommended by the CDC. Staff is frequently reminded and encouraged to practice social distancing and to use hand sanitizer and frequently wash their hands when they are in the facility and out in the community. We ask them not to report to work if they have symptoms of illness.
